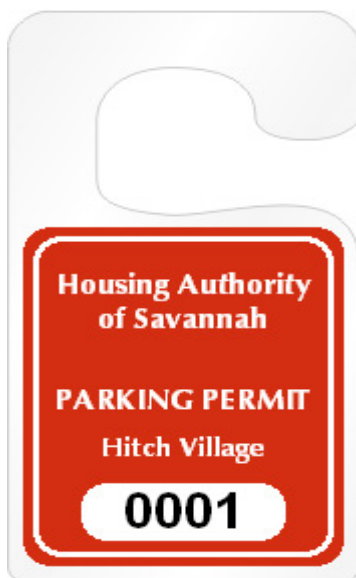


ATTENTION ALL RESIDENTS NEW PARKING REGULATIONS

The **Housing Authority of Savannah** will begin implementing new parking regulations in all neighborhoods during the month of August 2008. Parking violations on HAS properties will no longer be tolerated. These violations include parking on the grass, blocking the street or other vehicles, derelict or abandoned vehicles. Signs will be posted in all neighborhoods in the coming weeks, which will clearly outline parking regulations that must be adhered to in each of the HAS neighborhoods. Violators will have their vehicles **TOWED AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE**.



VEHICLES TO BE REGISTERED IN MANAGEMENT OFFICES MIRROR HANG TAGS TO BE ISSUED

All resident vehicles parked in HAS neighborhoods **MUST** be registered in the respective management offices. The Head of Household will be required to complete a Vehicle Registration Form and the completed form will be kept on file in the Management Office.

Once your vehicle has been registered, each Head of Household will be issued a Mirror Hang Tag. *Two hang tags will be issued per unit.*

\$75 FINE ISSUED FOR FIRST PARKING VIOLATION, THEN VEHICLE TO BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE

This hang tag must be hung from the rearview mirror of ALL vehicles when parked on HAS property. If you, the resident, or your guest, do not have your hang tag displayed and/or are illegally parked (on the grass; on the sidewalk; blocking another vehicle; an abandoned vehicle, etc.), Management will issue a warning.

A green parking violation sticker will be placed on the windshield of the illegally parked vehicle and a **\$75 fine** will be issued.

If the illegally parked or derelict/abandoned vehicle is not moved within 24 hours, the vehicle will be **towed at the owner's expense**.



Meetings will be held in each of your neighborhoods to discuss these rules and residents are encouraged to attend to have your questions answered.
